
## Create, annotate, and share

This guide will teach you how to create and share engaging learning resources for your students. It's yours to play with, so ignore the voice in your head saying that drawing on things is bad, and have fun!


## Step 1: Create





## Step 2: Annotate


Next, experiment with some of our favorite annotation tools to make your resource more engaging.
